## Environmental Policy Statement

At PB Design and Development Ltd we are committed to minimising our impact on the environment. As part of this we will ensure that we meet and if possible exceed all legal and other binding requirements. We also recognize this approach as sound business sense and are therefore motivated to continually improving our environmental performance.

Our activities involve the design, manufacture, supply, commissioning and servicing of standby power and associated equipment. The most significant environmental aspects of our Business are waste management and carbon emissions from site & vehicles. These provide a focus for our improvement plans. We are registered with the Environment Agency as a Carrier of Controlled Waste and are also members of a WEEE Compliance Scheme and a Registered Battery Producer (see [www.pbdesign.co.uk](http://www.pbdesign.co.uk) for details).

The Company is in the process of implementing an Environmental Management System in accordance with the requirements of ISO 14001. This System applies to all of the activities of P B Design and Developments Limited, including our manufacturing site in Clevedon and works at customer sites.

Segregation of waste has enabled us to reuse or recycle most of our waste, including batteries and WEEE. We seek to reduce the residual amounts for disposal. Since starting to collect data in 2003, we have reduced our CO2 emissions from electricity and gas by 33% despite our levels of activity more than doubling.

Our objectives for this year include trialling LPG vans with our service engineers, providing defensive driving training for company vehicle drivers, further segregation of our disposed waste especially plastics, and certification to ISO14001.

Environmental performance and operations are continually monitored at regular meetings convened by the Director responsible, who ensures that adequate resources are available as required. Each year this Environmental Policy Statement along with our Environmental Management System is formally reviewed by the Director and others at a Management Review Meeting. The Managing Director has overall responsibility for environmental matters within the Company.

This Policy has been communicated to all employees and is available to the Public. Our employees are also given the necessary information and training, and are held responsible for complying with the Policy.
