



Environmental Policy Statement

At PB Design and Development Ltd we are committed to minimising our impact on the environment and preventing pollution. We intend to meet, and if possible, exceed all legal and other compliance requirements. We recognize this approach is sound business sense and are therefore motivated to continually improving our environmental performance.

Our activities involve the design, manufacture, supply, installation, commissioning and servicing of standby power equipment, along with other associated bought-in products. The most significant environmental aspects of our Business include waste management, carbon emissions, emergencies and our own products. These provide a focus for our improvement plans.

Segregation of waste has enabled us to recycle and re-use our waste, including batteries and Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment (WEEE). Consequently, we have minimised the amount of residual waste, which is incinerated and converted into energy or construction materials, rather than sent to landfill.

Our factory is now free of CO₂ emissions from electricity and gas due to the solar installation on our factory and the importation of carbon-free electricity and gas. The electricity is from renewable sources and the gas is produced from sewerage waste.

We are registered as a carrier of controlled waste, waste storage operation, and UK battery producer. We are also members of a WEEE Compliance Scheme. See "About us" at www.pbdesign.co.uk.

The Company has an Environmental Management System (EMS) which is certified to ISO14001:2015, with the scope including all onsite and offsite activities of P B Design and Developments Limited.

Our objectives for 2020 are: -

1. To reduce our electricity consumption during the year by 20%.
2. To reduce our indexed gas consumption during the year by 15%.
3. To reduce our vehicle footprint in the year to a total of <= 50 tonnes of CO².
4. Implement actions recommended by the Life Cycle Analysis of our new switch mode charger.
5. Investigate the methodology of "Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Reporting", "Carbon Neutral" and PAS2060:2014 along with the feasibility of achieving scope 2 neutrality.

Our Directors convene meetings to ensure that our EMS is effective. Each year this Environmental Policy Statement along with our EMS is formally reviewed by a Director and others at a Management Review Meeting. The Managing Director has overall responsibility for environmental matters within the Company.

This Policy has been communicated to all employees and is available to the Public. Our employees are also given the necessary information and training and held responsible for complying with this Policy.
